Adopt-A-Spot Program

- Adopters will agree to a minimum of a **1-year agreement**, renewable upon approval.
- Litter pick-up will be at a minimum of **1 time per month** during the 1-year adoption period. One of the pick-ups must occur on the City of Lancaster's Annual Trash-Off.
- The City of Lancaster will be responsible for supplying trash bags, pick up and disposal of trash bags after each group completes clean up in their adopted area.

The Adopt-a-Spot program is a joint effort between your City government and the residents to keep our rights-of-way and neighborhoods clean and beautiful.

Illegal Dumping



What is Illegal Dumping?

Illegal Dumping occurs when a person places, deposits, dumps or accumulates refuse on or in any public or private street, public right-of-way or easement, gutter or sidewalk within the Lancaster City limits.

Why is Illegal Dumping a problem?

- Property values decline.
- Illegally dumped material can become a breeding ground for vectors, such as mice, rats and mosquitoes, which can spread diseases such as encephalitis, Hantavirus pulmonary syndrome and West Nile Disease.
- Illegal dumping is hazardous to the environment. From refrigerators to tires to auto parts to televisions, many contain heavy metals and other toxins.
- Illegal dumping costs taxpayers money.

Legal Alternatives to dispose of your unwanted items:

- Drop off your waste free of charge at the CWD transfer station located at **2010 California Crossing Dallas, TX 75220**. A copy of your water bill is required.
- Order a special pick up at 972-218-1300. This allows residents to schedule a pickup of bulky waste at a decent fee.
- You may drop off your waste at the Trash-off events.
- Move the unwanted items away from public view until the next Bulk/brush collection.

Fine for Illegal Dumping

Up to \$4,000.00

How can You Help?

- Report it! Call 972-218-1200 and provide information that leads to a citation of the illegal dumper.

If you spot illegal dumping, report it promptly! Visit www.lancaster-tx.com and click on the "Report a Concern" button to make a report.

Drop off your waste free of charge at the CWD transfer station located at 2010 California Crossing Dallas, TX 75220. A copy of your water bill is required!

You may also drop off your waste free of charge at our quarterly Trash-Offs located at 1501 N. Dallas Ave Lancaster, TX 75146. The next trash off event will be July 20, 2024!

Bulky Waste & Brush

Bulky waste will be collected every other month, according to the schedule below.

1 cubic yard is equivalent to approximately one washing machine.



You are limited to 12 cubic yards of bulky waste and brush per collection.

Tree limbs must be placed with trunks parallel to the street without obstructing the sidewalk. Individual items or bundles must weigh less than 50 pounds, and be no longer than 10 feet.

Place all bulk and brush items at your curb no later than 7:00 a.m. on the Monday of your service week.

Bulky Waste - Acceptable

Toys and Yard Tools Tagged as "Bulk Item"

Furniture

Bundled Carpet in 4-foot Lengths

Fence Panels No Larger than 4'x6'

Thorny Vines Must be Bagged or in Containers

Bagged Leaves (10 Bag Limit)

Washing Machines, Dryers, Water Heaters and Kitchen Appliances

Refrigerators/Freezers
(Must be tagged certifying removal of refrigerants)


Bulky Waste - Prohibited

Commercial Remodeling/Construction Debris

Household Hazardous Waste

Tires, Batteries, and Propane Tanks

Loose Household Debris
(Debris must be placed in a box or other container no larger than 2'x2'x4' and weighing no more than 50 pounds.)



Not your service month? You may drop off up to 12 cubic yards of bulky waste and brush at the CWD Transfer Station, 2010 California Crossing Road, Dallas, TX 75220. Resident Sidewalk Replacement

50/50 Program

Cost Sharing for Residential Sidewalk Replacement

Program Steps:



- Citizen contacts City and asks to participate in the Cost Share program.
- If funds for the current fiscal year are not available, the citizen's name is added to a group list for the following year. When funding for the following fiscal year becomes available, city staff will contact citizens through individual authorization letters, requesting a response indicating interest in continuing with the program.
- For each positive response, city staff visits the property and assesses the sidewalk repair needs.
- City staff sends the citizen an individual quote for the cost share, a sketch of the replacement limits and a 30-day deadline for submitting payments.
- City staff then prepares a contract with the residential property owner.
- The work is completed by the city and comes with a one-year warranty.

50/50 Sidewalk Replacement Program Application

The 50/50 Sidewalk Program provides owners of residential property occupying their home with an opportunity to replace defective sidewalks in front of their parcels for half of the total cost. For non-resident property owners not occupying the home, the city manages 40% of the cost. Sidewalks that qualify are typically rated as fair to poor. Sidewalks in good condition will not qualify for the program. Work will be completed within 60 days of payment being received.

Eligibility

Participation is open to owners of residential properties.

Process

1. The applicant completes this form, and submits it by one of the following:
 - a. Email: rsingleton@lancaster-tx.com and psilva@lancaster-tx.com
 - b. Mail to: Public Works Department PO Box 940, Lancaster, TX, 75146
2. The City inspects the existing sidewalk to determine if the sidewalk qualifies for the program and notifies the applicant.
3. If the sidewalk qualifies, the Public Works Department provides a letter explaining the cost of the project to the applicant, using pricing from the annual sidewalk contract that is bid by the City to a private contractor.
4. The applicant must then determine whether or not to proceed. **Work will not be schedule until payment is received.**

LANCASTER EYES & EARS PROGRAM

Lancaster Eyes and Ears Program (LEEP)

The City of Lancaster Code Compliance division is seeking volunteers to join the Lancaster eyes and ears program (LEEP)

The LEEP program will primarily perform duties in the field identifying code violations for code officers to perform further investigation. The program is intended to have volunteers aid city staff in improving and preserving the quality of life in our community. These volunteers will help act as the "eyes and ears" in residential and commercial neighborhoods to staff code compliance officers. Citizens are key to identifying potentially serious problems.

Essential duties and responsibilities:

Patrol assigned areas to identify code violations such as:

- Excessive accumulation of trash and debris;
- Parking of vehicles, boats, trailers on unimproved surfaces;
- High grass and overgrown weeds/vegetation;
- Junk vehicles;
- Illegal dumping and litter; and
- Illegal placement of signs

LEEP volunteers will be asked to take photos of the identified violation and submit with the address to the code compliance division. The volunteers would only be able to provide limited information to property owners and residents concerning the correction of violations, bulk trash pickup procedures, and adhere to the expectation of privacy and personal safety.

Qualifications:

Volunteers are requested to volunteer a minimum of 4 hours per week. Work schedules are flexible based on your availability but are limited to daytime hours. Volunteers must possess a Texas class "C" driver's license, successfully complete a background check and drug test, reside in the City of Lancaster.

Training:

The basic training includes, reviewing the relevant municipal code sections, criteria for determining if the conditions and known facts constitute an actual violation and how to work cooperatively with people to avoid confrontation and be a good ambassador for the city. The overall goal is to target, the problem not the people.

Training will include a total of five, 2 hour sessions with code officers to educate volunteers on different code violations that may occur in the field. The training session will include 1 hour inside and 1 hour in the field with a code officer. Volunteers will be trained on what violations are and what they may look like in the field as well as procedures of reporting to code office.

Benefits:

- Knowledge that you are benefitting your neighbors with questions about code compliance matters.
