

Background:

Staff will give an update regarding the 2018 Annual Youth Advisory Committee Summit.

The 18th Annual YAC Summit is a two-day statewide event hosted by the City of Cedar Hill and sponsored by the Texas Municipal League. The 2018 Summit will be held in Cedar Hill on February 17-18, 2018. This year's theme is "Gain and Sustain" and will focus on leadership and sustainability.

The Youth Advisory Commission (YAC) Summit is an opportunity for cities, schools, and community youth groups to share the experiences of their programs and the positive impact that the programs have had locally. The summit is organized to promote a fun environment for youth and city leaders to learn from and work with each other. Adults and students will leave with a greater appreciation of their own programs and new ideas to move their group forward in coming years.

Staff is seeking to brief YAC members to determine their availability to participate and possibly present at this year's summit.

Dress Code
