
Dallas County Conducts Ground Spraying Due to Positive Mosquito Trap

Lancaster, TX – A positive West Nile Virus mosquito trap was confirmed by Dallas County for the 1100 block of Nancy Lane in the City of Lancaster on Wednesday, August 14, 2019. In conjunction with Dallas County Health and Human Services (DCHHS), mosquito abatement teams are responding by treating impacted areas. DCHHS has scheduled ground spraying in the below area(s), weather permitting:

Wednesday, August 14, 2019, 9:00 pm to 5:00 am

Thursday, August 15, 2019, 9:00 pm to 5:00 am

Although the pesticide is approved by the Environmental Protection Agency, residents are advised to take the following precautions: Minimize exposure, remain indoors during the hours while spraying is in progress. Spraying will not be conducted in the event of wind speeds more than 10 mph or inclement weather.

“Mosquito season is here and we want the residents of Dallas County to know to expect more positive traps this season and to remember the 4 Ds.” said Dr. Philip Huang, DCHHS Director.

Residents should use the 4Ds to reduce exposure to mosquitoes:

- **DEET All day, Every day:** Whenever outside, use insect repellents that have the active ingredient DEET or other EPA-registered repellents and always follow label instructions.
- **Dress:** Wear long, loose, and light-colored clothing outside.
- **Drain:** Drain or treat all standing water in and around your home or workplace where mosquitoes could
