Councilmembers departed the James R. Williams Pump Station at 5:00 p.m. and traveled to the elevated water tank at 1011 E. Beltline Road. Water/wastewater Superintendent Curtis gave a briefing regarding the facility. The tour continued traveling through the City's ETJ area. City Manager Mauldin Robertson noted points of interest in the area, the proposed Loop 9 alignment and highlighted areas receiving water service from Rockett Water.

The tour continued to the Pump Station at 3648 Ames Road. Water/wastewater Superintendent Curtis provided a briefing on operations at this Pump Station. The tour departed the Ames Pump Station and traveled past the 342 Lift Station at 4133 N. Dallas Avenue. The tour ended at the James R. Williams Pump Station.
