Lancaster Begins Ground Spraying

Lancaster, TX – The City of Lancaster has coordinated with Dallas County Health and Human Services in implementing the Four-County West Nile Virus Mosquito Plan for 2013. Selected neighborhoods in Lancaster will be sprayed on Thursday, June 13th starting at 10 p.m.

Proactive treatment will begin due to high trap counts of mosquitoes in the designated areas. Dallas County will be providing ground spraying for targeted areas until completion. Residents in these areas are asked to remain indoors during the spraying. The areas to be sprayed are depicted on the map attached.
