Please use the <u>white card for Public Testimony/Citizens' Comments</u> and the <u>gold card for Public Hearings</u>. Please turn the form in to the City Secretary prior to the start of the Council Meeting.
- If you do not want to address the Council but would like it known that you are in favor or opposition to an agenda item, please mark the appropriate section on Request to Speak form for <u>Public Testimony/Citizens' Comments</u> or <u>gold card for Public Hearings</u>.
- The Mayor will ask for those wishing to address the Council to do so at the appropriate time.
 Please approach the speaker's podium, state your name and address for the record, and discuss the topic of interest or public hearing item. Please direct your comments to the Mayor and City Council.
- Please avoid personal attacks, accusations, and characterizations. We ask that you treat other
 people, the community, and the City Council with respect.
- Public Testimony/Citizens' Comments will be limited to 3 minutes.
- Comments during Public Hearings may be limited to a specific amount of time at the discretion of the Mayor (presiding officer) to allow all interested persons an opportunity to speak.
