
## COMMUNITY FOCUSED

# CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION

The Criminal Investigations Division is headed by Lieutenant D. Clark. There are four detectives, a CID Technician and four Public Safety Officers in the division.

The Criminal Investigation Division investigates a range of serious crimes, including arson, auto theft, burglary, felony vandalism, hate crimes, fraud, theft, homicide, robbery, aggravated battery, felony domestic violence, elderly abuse, sexual battery and child abuse. After thorough investigation, CID prepares and files criminal cases with the Dallas County District Attorney's Office for prosecution.

Members of this Division also support this function through crime scene processing, fingerprint analysis, sexual offender monitoring, criminal intelligence analysis, missing person's investigations and fugitive apprehension.

- Conduct Business Security Surveys




# K9 DIVISION


